

## **Music at Beechwood Primary School**

By the end of studying Music at Beechwood Primary School, children will have had the opportunity to develop a mastery knowledge and an enjoyment of music. Children will be able to talk about and share their musical knowledge in the following strands:

- Singing (how to sing expressively and in unison following a conductor)
- Listening (recognise different musical styles and elements such as tempo and staccato)
- Composing (playing instruments, notation, improvising and composing)
- Performing (create, rehearse, and evaluate performances)
- Musicianship (using body percussion, instruments, and voices)

All music end points will be covered using specialist music schemes: Charanga - Original Curriculum (EYFS), Charanga Model Music Curriculum (Year 1,2 and 3) and Puzzle Pieces through Accent Music Education Hub (Year 4, 5 and 6).
