Belongings

At Beechwood we are a music ambassador school and take pride in the quality our music education. As part of this, pupils in years 4, 5 and 6 are taught to play instruments in their music lessons. Pupils will be allowed to take their instruments home to practice, please support in this fantastic opportunity by ensuring that instruments are used at home and are returned to school each week ready for their lesson.



Home Reading

We cannot express enough the importance of your child reading at home; it sets them up for life-long learning, enjoyment and creativity! As we have previously explained, children are expected to read at least 3 times a week in EYFS and KS1 and 5 times a week in KS2. Reading Diaries will be checked each week and rewards will be given for those children reading the right amount.

Please sign your child's reading diary, which needs to be in school each day. You can use this diary to add little comments on how well your child read.

Please ensure your child reads for at least 20 minutes in each sitting: reading stamina needs to be built up so that the children can read 90 (KS1), 110 (Y3/4) and 140 (Y5/6) words per minute.

As your child becomes more independent in their reading, it is still important to hear them read so that you can check for fluency, accuracy and understanding of new words and their ability to read with expression. Asking them which new words they have found in this book and what it means is a good way to check their understanding.

Finally, thank you for understanding why we need books bags rather than rucksacks or backpacks.

As Throughout school we use music throughout the school day to help children with the busy transitions and ensure that they are ready to learn. Each half term we have a different focus composer or music style so that the children can become familiar with a range of music. The children will listen to their music each morning and find out key facts about them. We also encourage pupils to do their own research on them. Our composer for autumn 1 is... Mozart

Literacy	This half term in Literacy we are exploring the book The Enormous Turnip. We will be having a focus on orally retelling the story. We will be using our new learned phonics knowledge on writing initial sounds for activities relating to our class story. We we ensure we have a dominant hand when writing and are holding our pencils correctly.
Maths	In Maths this half term we will be focusing on Numbers of the Week. We will be looking at numbers 0-4 and discussing what they look like, where we may see them around us, shapes related to that number, how to make that number whilst using vocabulary such as 'more' and 'less'.
Understanding	In Understanding the World, we will explore The Woodland topic in Geography and what we may find in the woodland. We will focus on
the World	celebrations in RE and how different religions have different celebrations. Harvest festival is a celebration we will explore, as a whole school. In provision we also have our home role play and our Autumnal Season exploration area.
Expressive	This half term we have looked into the artist Picasso and have created
Arts and	portraits in the style of Picasso. Children will also be able to freely create their own pictures inspired by Picasso within provision. In Music we will be
Design	learning nursery rhymes and singing in time to one another as a class and in small groups, focusing on timing and pitch. In provision we will be making our own creations, music and role play whilst able to talk about the process we used to create them.
Physical	In Physical Development this half term we will have a focus on our fine
Development	motor skills. We will complete activities using playdough, tweezers and threading to ensure we develop our fine motor skills which enables us to control our pen/pencils when drawing or writing. In P.E we will explore skills such as spatial awareness, ball control and team work in our Invasion Games topic.

Communication and Language	In communication and Language we build on listening and responding to others in sentences. We have story time at the end of each day and discuss each book, being able to recall some information from the story or key events. We build relationships with our peers and engage in back and forth conversations during activity time or during role play, implementing new learnt vocabulary in our conversations.

Rosen Class

English	This half term we begin with a fiction unit based on the story 'The Three Billy Goats Gruff'. We will be learning the story and innovating it with our own versions. We will also be looking at labelling and captions using adjectives. We will have a big focus on writing in sentences with a capital letter and full stop and also on letter formation using our cursive script.
Maths	The Autumn term in Year 1 is all about introducing the children to our maths scheme 'Singapore Maths'. We begin deepening our understanding of 'counting to 10', counting, writing, comparing, and ordering these numbers. With each unit the children are being taught the mathematical concepts before moving onto problem-solving and group work and finally 'journaling' to show what their understanding is.
Topic	This year starts off with a history unit on 'Toys and Technology'. We will learn how toys and technology in the home have changed since 1950 and the impact on our lives. We will look at what technology we use in our homes today and compare it to the olden days.
Science	The Autumn Term brings a focus on 'Animals including Humans'. We will identify and name a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals. We will also identify and name a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.
RE	This term we will be looking at 'Christianity'. Firstly, we will be answering the question 'Why do Christians say that God is a 'Father'?' We will explore Christian use of the word 'Father' and consider the importance of prayer in Christian life.
PE	This half term we will focus on Invasion games skills and Net and wall games skills. This will involve lots of dribbling, catching and throwing and moving around safely in a limited space.
RSE	Our first topic in Y1 is 'Families and Relationships'. We will be exploring how families can be different and the characteristics and impact of positive friendships. We will be learning that issues can be overcome, people show feelings differently and that stereotyping is unfair.
ART	This half term Year 1 will be looking at Drawing- 'Making your mark.' We will focus on experimenting with media, mark making, making waves and exploring lines and colour. We will then develop our drawing skills and draw from observation.
Music	Our Music unit is called 'Hey You'. The children will be learning how pulse, rhythm and pitch work together. We start each lesson by listening to a piece of music, we find the pulse as we listen and dance as the music takes us. Musical Activities will include finding the pulse, marching in time and clapping rhythms, we will have fun singing too. We will play instruments, improvise and compose a simple melody using simple rhythms.

Attenborough Class

English	This half term we are going to be inspired by the story 'Jack and the Beanstalk'. The children will be innovating their own version of the story with a new character and setting. We will use the story to write a letter of complaint from the giant.
Maths	In maths, we will be starting with place value of numbers to 100 including finding and completing number patterns. We will then be focusing on addition and subtraction, this include using number bonds and learning the column method. We will then be starting to explore multiplication of groups of 2, 5 and 10.
History	Our history topic for Autumn term is transport. As part of this we will be looking at key influential historical figures and their achievements including: Christopher Columbus, Neil Armstrong and Francis Egerton.
Science	Throughout Autumn we are learning about Animals including Humans. In this unit, we will be finding out about the basic needs of all animals and exploring how humans need food and exercise to stay healthy and fit. We will also be looking at the offspring of different animals.
RE	In RE, we will be posing the question 'Does how we treat our world matter?' through this unit we will learn about the Christian creation story as well as how harvest is celebrated.
Computing	We are going to be learning about staying safe online, this includes recognising the importance of passwords and what information is safe to share.
PE	Year 2 PE day is on a Wednesday. This half term we will be learning the skills for and participating in Net and wall games.
RSE	In RSE, we will be learning about Families and Relationships. We will be exploring the importance of friendships and families and exploring ways of solving problems with our friends.
ART	We are focusing on the skill of drawing, across our art unit we will be exploring ways of drawing in different styles including observational drawings and using our skills to illustrate a story.
DT	In DT, we will be using our textiles knowledge of stitching and cutting fabric to design and make pouches.

Pankhurst Class

Find out what we are learning about this half term

English	In our writing, we are going to be studying a finding tale called 'The Egg', we will be learning different skills throughout the unit that we will use in our final writing piece of creating an alternate version of the story, changing the characters, setting and ending!
Maths	In maths, we will be completing our Place Value unit. Pupils will look at numbers up to 1000 and focuses on the value of each digit, learn how to compose and decompose numbers, compare, order and look for patterns. We will then move on to addition and subtraction with renaming.
History	This half term's topic is the Anglo Saxons and Scots. Focusing on the evidence of Anglo-Saxon settlements, what impact they have had on our lives today and why Scotland is called Scotland.
Science	In science, we are learning about Animals including humans. Investigating food groups and nutrients needed for a balanced diet and observing the human skeleton.
RE	This half term, we are looking at Christianity. Our big question for the unit will be 'Who should we follow?'. We will explore Christian beliefs about leadership and how we can link this to our everyday life.
PE	In PE this half term we will be completing Invasion Games, we will take part in a different game a week that focuses on a different skill involving positioning, dodging and communication. We will also be studying Netball, learning to pass and shoot accurately to play a game.
ART	In art this half term we will be focusing on Abstract Shape using 3D sculptures. We will look at how to combine shapes together using different joins and holds together. To help us with our projects, if you have any spare cardboard or kitchen roll tubes please send them in to school with your child!
MFL	This half term, we will be looking at French greetings, both in spoken and written forms. We will learn how to take turns to speak using appropriate intonation.

Mandela Class

English	This half term we begin by learning how to write a suspense story. We will create a toolkit that will enable us to develop our writing skills and create tension and suspense into our own independent writing. Moving on from this, we will be learning to use our persuasive skills in our non-fiction unit.
Maths	Year 6 will be continuing their Singapore Maths journey which will be begin with place value of numbers up to 1 million. We will focus on a range of methods including bar models to aid our understanding and how to use this to support us when problem solving. Moving on from this, we will be focusing on developing our knowledge of the four operations and mixed number calculations.
History	Our history topic for Autumn term is WWI and WWII. As part of this we will be looking at key sources of evidence that will help to us investigate how and why these wars took place. We will also look at why children had to evacuate Liverpool during this time.
Science	Throughout Autumn we are learning about Animals including Humans. In this unit, we will be learning to identify and name the main parts of the human circulatory system, and describe the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood. We will learn to recognise the impact of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle on the way their bodies function.
RE	In RE, we will be focusing on the question 'Is life like a journey?' We will explore the purpose of life and how is it always easy to show forgiveness.
Computing	We are going to be learning about staying safe online, this includes recognising the importance of passwords and what information is safe to share.
PE	Our PE unit this half term is Netball. We will be learning the tactical skills required to attack and defend during a match.
RSE	In our first unit of Families and Relationships, we will be learning: to resolve conflict, through negotiation and compromise; about respect, understanding that everyone deserves to be respected and about grief.
DT	In DT, we will be researching recipes to create our own 3 course menu. The children will learn to follow a recipe to create their dishes before tasting and evaluating their creations.
