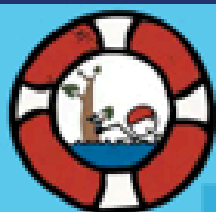
Non Uniform Day- Bottle Donation

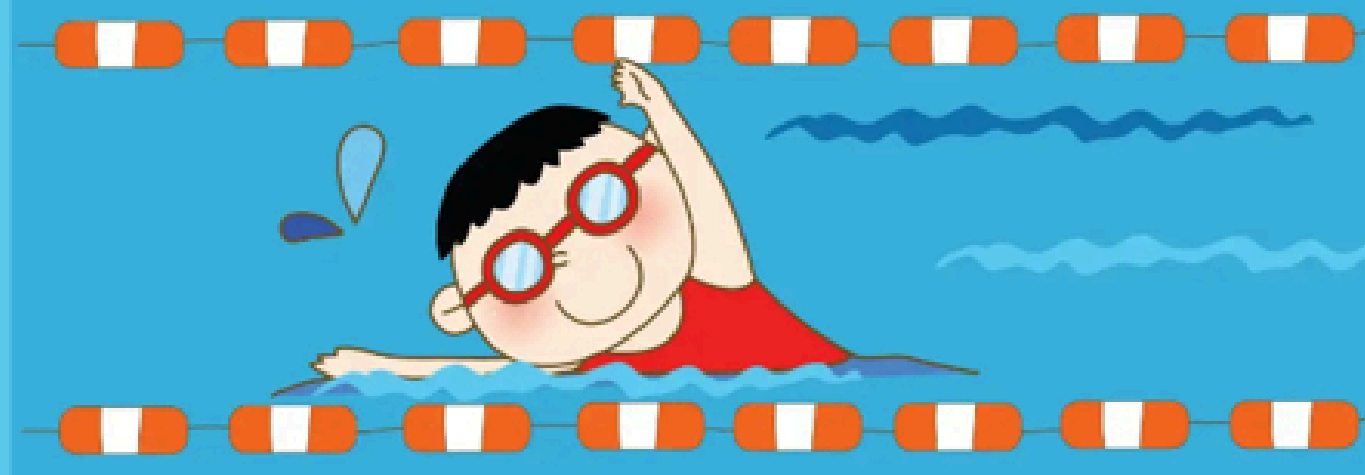

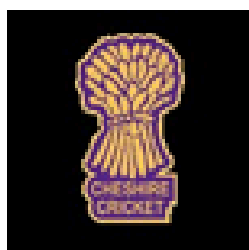
