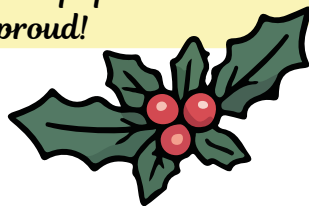


DARE WE SAY 'CHRISTMAS'?

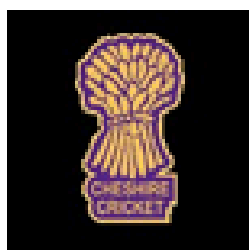
