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### **Beechwood School PTA Meeting Minutes 11/11/2019**

#### **General**

Kelly Campbell enquired as to whether Bernadette Hughes had been paid yet. Kirsty Ap-Carreg hasn't done so yet but will sort a cheque out asap.

The poet Matt Goodfellow is booked in for Friday the 6<sup>th</sup> of March, the day after World Book Day. It was discussed whether we should change the day the kids dress up for world book day from Thursday the 5<sup>th</sup> to the Friday to coincide with his visit. Mrs Kidd to confirm closer to the time.

Andrea from Helen O'Grady is booked in for the term straight after Christmas. Mrs Kidd is to confirm with Andrea details of what she will be teaching prior to the sessions.

The panto that came into the school hasn't been booked yet as we are waiting for the Black Friday deal to come on. Kelly Campbell and Mrs Kidd are to liaise with regards to what dates would be best and any that need to be avoided so that we can react quickly once the offer goes online.

Kelly Campbell asked if we had had anymore information on the bouldering wall/playground revamp. Mrs Kidd said we are awaiting the sales consultant to come in to give us a quote.

#### **Pamper Night Planning**

11 stalls have been booked and have prepaid which means the event can go ahead (11/12 stalls is the optimum number). Kelly Campbell is to let Karen McIntyre know what type of stall are booked so that they can be added to the facebook posts.

School and Kelly Campbell are to liase with the community centre and the local nusery to ask if they could also advertise the event on their forums.

Letters have been prepared by Emma Illing and Karen McIntyre is to arrange a time to go into school to photocopy them, ready to go out in school bags.

The Bunny wheel has been booked and the delivery of L'Oreal goodies has arrived.

We have bottles from the dress down day to use as prizes on the night. Kirsty Ap-Carreg has raffle tickets that can also be used.

Teas and coffee will be available on the night for people to purchase.

Kelly Campbell has designed new games to play to win the L'Oreal prizes involcing envelopes, some conatinig prizes, some containing money, She has also purchased a pack of cards for a game to win the bottles.

### **Christmas Bonanza**

### **AOB**

Karen McIntyre pointed out that the family quiz night that was arranged for Tuesday the 19<sup>th</sup> of May is when the year 4's are on their residential and

asked if there was any way tis could be changed. Mrs Kidd has now set the date to Thursday the 14<sup>th</sup> of May.

Karen McIntyre asked if there was enough money in the PTA to maybe look at starting to provide year 6 leavers hoodies. LAthough this does seem like a good idea it was discussed what would happen if in future years we didn't have enough money. Would those years miss out?? Karen McIntyre is to loook into the costings and to see if this would be a viable option.

This brought about a discussion about possible having a voting system set up in the school hall similar to the token system at asda. We could look at 3 things the PTA could purchase and children/parents would use pennies to vote for their favourite option.

There was a discussion involving how to get more parents involved with the PTA. It was mentioned how we had tried parent reps for each year group in the past and this was maybe something we could look into again for the future.
